- **Curriculum Design**: Develop course objectives, learning outcomes, and lesson plans that align with the subject matter and target audience.
- **Content Creation**: Create engaging multimedia content including videos, presentations, quizzes, assignments, readings, and interactive elements.
- **Instructional Design**: Apply pedagogical principles to design effective learning experiences, ensuring content is structured in a logical and sequential manner.
- **Technology Integration**: Utilize learning management systems (LMS), authoring tools, and multimedia software to deliver content effectively online.
- **Assessment Development**: Design formative and summative assessments to measure student learning and provide feedback for improvement.
- Accessibility Compliance: Ensure course materials meet accessibility standards, making them usable for all learners, including those with disabilities.
- **Multimedia Production**: Record and edit video/audio content, create graphics, and design visually appealing materials to enhance learning.
- Quality Assurance: Review course materials for accuracy, relevance, and effectiveness, and continuously improve content based on feedback and evaluation.

- Sufficient mobility and physical stamina to teach online courses.

- Successful course development and teaching experience at the university level and industry experience
